SKI & SNOWBOARD GROUP LESSONS

Thank you for purchasing your lesson with us! We look forward to sharing the passion of the sport and our environment with you.

We understand that it can be intimidating to start a new sport, but want to assure you that we have the best Pros, terrain and attitude to help you learn the proper skills to navigate the slopes!

LOCATION:

Snowmass

Skiers: Meet at the top of the Elk Camp Gondola (allow 15minutes to ride up), a special beginner's area called the Elk Camp Meadows is located at the top. Elk Camp Meadows offers gentle terrain that is excellent for learning.

Snowboarders: Meet at the Base Village Plaza (by the Fire Pit) next to the Base Camp Restaurant, After meeting your Pro you will take the Elk Camp Gondola up to the mid-way station to access Assay Hill. Assay Hill provides the perfect terrain for learning how to ride!

Buttermilk: Skiers and Snowboarders meet at the base of the Summit Express lift. Beginner lessons take place on famous Panda Peak with specially groomed beginner terrain located at the base.

Times: Full day: 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Please arrive at your lesson meeting area at 9:45 a.m.

Rentals: Allow an extra hour if you are renting equipment. If possible, pick up your equipment the day before at any of our Four Mountain Sports rental shops. If your SKI lesson is at Snowmass, we have a Beginner's Magic rental shop at the TOP of the Elk Camp Gondola. If time allows, head up the gondola at 9am and get all your gear at the top. If your SNOWBOARD lesson is at Snowmass; your rental equipment is located at the Four Mountain Sports at the BOTTOM of the gondola. For lesson at Buttermilk Four Mountain Sports is conveniently located adjacent to the parking lot at the base of Buttermilk.

Cost:

Full day: \$199 Full day with 7-day advance purchase: \$189

Three (3) full days: \$405 Three (3) full days with 7-day advance purchase: \$387

Includes: Lesson, rental equipment, and a beginner area-lift ticket.

New this year, your lesson ticket will be loaded onto your lift ticket or season pass. Separate lesson tickets will not be issued. You must have your ticket/pass to join a lesson.

Helmets: Helmets are highly recommended for skiing and snowboarding. Helmets are also required for all participants, regardless of age, when participating in Terrain Park & Pipe lessons. While helmets may reduce the severity of a head injury, the best way to avoid accidents is to know and abide by the skier/rider responsibility code.

Helpful Hints:

- Make sure you are hydrated before the lesson so that you can handle the elevation and exercise
- Leave the cotton clothing at home. Dress in moisture wicking layers, even in the cold.
